### **Notice To Exhibitors**

- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, or telephoned entries cannot be accepted. Entries without fees cannot be accepted. Fax entries with credit card authorization are allowed and must include the Agreement with the Entry Form.
- PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY or type using black or blue ink. Do not use pencil, or colored inks to write entries.
- ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Changes by telephone are not acceptable.
- ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, in season, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, extreme weather conditions (including, but not limited to, extreme heat, snowstorms, hurricanes, floods, or earthquakes), or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. The safety and well-being of the dogs, exhibitors, and judges is of paramount importance.
- CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY & SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME will be sent to the address
  on the Official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy
  of the Schedule within seven days of the trial, the Trial Secretary should be contacted.
- DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE TRIAL only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately after unless required for further judging.

### **Additional Trial Rules**

- 1. Dogs must be kept on leash except when in the obedience ring.
- Dogs not regularly entered will not be allowed within the precincts of the trial during its continuance.
- THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.
- Consult Judging Program for time of judging. Exhibitors are responsible for having their dogs at ringside when it is their turn to be judged. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused after their class has been judged.
- In the case of a tie for any prize, any dog that is not present for a run-off will forfeit its rights to the prize.
- 6. There will be no admission charge for spectators at this Trial.
- Acknowledgement of receipt of entries will be made soon after the closing date. Should such
  acknowledgement not be received by an exhibitor seven days prior to the Trial, please
  contact the Trial Secretary.
- No Special Award will be mailed or delivered. An exhibitor whose dog is eligible for a Special Award must be present or appoint a representative to accept the award.
- 9. All exhibitors who are qualified to compete for Special Awards may fill out the enclosed form and return it with entry or obtain and complete form the day of the Trial, provided such form is handed to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the class in which they are entered.
- 10. No provisions will be made for unentered dogs.

Highest Combined Score in Rally Advanced B and Rally Excellent B. A Director's Chair is offered by the Santa Clara Dog Training Club. To qualify, a team (same dog & handler) will have achieved a qualifying score in both the Advanced B and Excellent B Rally classes. The winner will be the team with the highest combined total, determined by adding the two scores together. In the case of several teams having the same combined total score, their times from the two classes will be added together. The winner will be the team with the highest combined total score and the lowest combined total time. In case of a tie in both combined scores and combined times, the winner will be determined by a run-off at the conclusion of the Rally trial using the Excellent B course from earlier in the trial, with the Honor Exercise omitted. A maximum of five minutes will be allowed to re-walk the course.
