Awards

Ribbons will be awarded 1st—4th place in each jump height class to dogs earning a qualifying score. Dog leashes will be awarded to 1st place in each jump height class to dogs earning a qualifying score. Medallions will be awarded to all dogs completing a title. Green Ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score. Master dogs earning a Double, Triple or Quadruple Q will be awarded a corresponding pin. Dogs earning the MACH or PACH title will receive a special rosette and bar.

Class Information, Jump Heights, Scoring

Classes offered: Regular Titling: Novice A & B, Open, Excellent & Master for Standard, JWW and FAST. Preferred: Novice, Open, Excellent & Master for Standard, JWW and FAST. Regular and Preferred T2B. Owners are responsible for entering the proper class and height. Complete rules can be found on the AKC website at www.akc.org. For a copy of the rule book write to: American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Dr., Raleigh, NC 27617-3390. To place a credit card order by telephone call: 919-233-9767 voice and 919-816-3627 fax. Minimum order is \$10. Obstacles will conform to the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

For each class worked Volunteers will receive a \$2 voucher. The \$2 vouchers are valid toward entry fees at next year's rally/agility trial or may be placed in the worker raffle to be drawn on Sunday.

Coffee, tea and snacks will be available each morning. Suggested donation \$1. Lunch must be pre-ordered. See separate order form. Lunch will be paid for crew chiefs, course builders, judges and score table and MUST be ordered in advance.

NQ Raffle will be held. Envelopes of cash so don't forget to ask Kit for your ticket. One ticket for each NQ.

Wait List: Santa Clara DTC offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trials' closing date/time. A maximum of 100 runs will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00 pm on April 24, 2014. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 6:00 pm on May 7, 2014 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry, a refund will be issued and mailed in the time frame of 7 days before to 7 days following the event. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm on May 7, 2014 will receive a FULL REFUND.



No vehicular traffic anywhere within 50 feet of a ring during show hours.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.
- Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fees.
- EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETE, ACCURATE, AND LEGIBLE INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS; ILLEGIBLE OR INCOMPLETE EINTRIES CANNOT BE ENTERED IN THE TRIAL.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- Dogs under four months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.
- Failure to follow the instructions of the Show Committee or the Show Chairperson or their Agent will result in a Bench Committee Hearing.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct will result in a Bench Committee Hearing.
- No refund for duplicate entry or entry in class that is not offered ie: FAST or T2B on days not offered.
- Refunds are mailed in the time frame of seven days before to seven days after the event.
- Withdrawal of entry before closing date will receive refund less \$7 processing fee.
- Refund of bitches after closing date is: amount paid less \$10 per day processing fee.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Course Familiarization/Warm-ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in the class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring.

Move-Up Regulations

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. Sunday move ups are allowed providing the Trial Secretary is notified at the show site, in writing, within 15 minutes of the last dog crossing the finish line on Saturday.

Trial Site

The trial will be held outdoors on grass, on the Country Fair Lawn located by the RV park. The rings will measure 100×100 . www.casadefruta.com. Parking on the lower grass area after 10 am on Thursday.

Directions:

Casa de Fruta is located 2 miles east of the junction of Highway 152 and Highway 156. From highway 5 take 152 West and travel approximately 28 miles.

From San Jose take 101 south to 152 east.

From Monterey take 101 north to 156 north/east to 152 east.

Follow the freeway signs to Casa de Fruta. Follow Frontage Rd past Casa de Diesel towards the RV park.

Parking is available through gate 6.

Overnight parking is available at the RV Orchard Resort. All reservations must be made directly with Casa de RV at rvmotel@casadefruta.com or 408-842-9316. Tent camping is available. You may request to park on the grass near the rings or in the regular RV park.
