In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The SCDTC reserve the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the SCDTC or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

This club does not agree to arbitrate as stated on the AKC entry form.

REFUNDS

No refunds will be given for overpayments of \$6.00 or under.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, weather or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

MOVE-UPS

All pre-show move ups must be received by 6pm, Monday, May 8, 2017. The AKC requires move-ups to be in writing. You may send an email for a move-up to agilityentry@mycci.net with your name, your dog's call name, the name & date of the trial and what class you want the dog to be moved to. If you miss the deadline for move-ups, you may move your dog up the first day of the show for any subsequent days, even if you are not showing a dog that day. In addition a friend may do the move-up for you if you are not there. However, you may not move up the day of the show for that day.
